The versatile Gen 3 USNV PVS-14A features a manual gain control which allows the user to increase or decrease image tube brightness for greater image contrast in varying light conditions. The USNV PVS-14A uses a Generation 3 image tube in a compact, high performance, mil-spec housing designed for multiple applications. The USNV PVS-14A can be hand-held, head-mounted, helmet-mounted, weapons mounted, and can be adapted to a camera/camcorder. The newly redesigned USNV-PVS-14A operates on a single "AA" battery and is built to fulfill the most demanding tactical applications. The newly offered White Phosphorus was originally introduced to the U.S. Military to reduce "eye strain". Antiquated Green Phosphorus night vision, when used for extensive periods of time, tires the eyes, which in turn tires the brain. White Phosphor softens the harshness and allows for extended use without the "eye strain".
